



NATIONAL LOTTERY DISTRIBUTION TRUST FUND (NLDTF) SPORT AND RECREATION CATEGORY

The Distributing Agency for Sport and Recreation, established in terms of the Lotteries Act (No.57 of 1997), is in position to consider applications for funding from the proceeds of the National Lottery in the Sport and Recreation Sector.

Applications are invited from sports organisations, clubs, schools, municipalities, tertiary institutions and sports councils. The aforementioned bodies can apply for funding as identified below.

MACRO BODIES can apply for:

- Delivery, co-ordination and presentation of Team SA to the multi-coded games.
- Hosting of major international events.
- Projects of National nature that will benefit all priority sporting codes.

NATIONAL FEDERATIONS can apply for:

- Capacity building for the following:
 1. Four-year plans for High Performance Programme, including talent identification and international participation.
 2. Training of technical officials, coaches, and administrators
- Hosting of major international events.
- National Academies.

PROVINCIAL AND REGIONAL FEDERATIONS can apply for:

- Equipment for their facilities/clubs.
- Generic training courses and Capacity Building.
- Upgrading of existing sport facilities, provided there is endorsement by the responsible National Federation.

PROVINCIAL ACADEMIES OF SPORT can apply for:

- Capacity building.
- Generic Training Courses.
- Equipment for training & supporting Federations during camps.

MUNICIPALITIES can apply for:

- Upgrading of existing facilities.

Applications from Municipalities should be part of an Integrated Development Plan and should be accompanied by a Council Resolution approving the upgrading of the identified sport facilities together with a commitment to maintain the facilities.

SCHOOLS can apply:

- Basic sport facilities and upgrading of existing facilities.
- Sports equipment & apparel.

TERTIARY INSTITUTIONS can apply for:

- Upgrading of existing sport facilities, where such facilities will have unhindered access to participants.
- Sport specific Research and Science in collaboration with National Federations and Macro Bodies.

CLUBS can apply for:

- Sport equipment and apparel (playing kit).
- Basic facilities & upgrading of existing facilities.

ALL APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Form 05/1 - completed in full.
2. Constitution or founding documents of the applicant.
3. Audited Financial Statements for the past two years that include an Audit Report by a Certificated Auditor/Audit firm.
4. Business plan and budget.
5. Proof of Registration.
6. Proof of recognition from:
 - Relevant Federation or SASCOC
 - Municipalities to obtain a letter of support from the relevant National Federation or Provincial Sport Structure.
 - Relevant Authority (Chief or tribal authority, affidavit from police station).

Please note that the NLDTF will not fund day-to-day running/operating costs or the costs for project management and commission.

Failure to comply with the advertised requirements will jeopardize your application for funding. The Agency reserves the right not to make grants.
